

TUITING AND FEES (Academic Year 2008-2009)

Estimating Graduate Student Fees and Tuition

Please use the following information for estimating the cost of graduate student tuition and fee remission for extramural proposal budgets. The estimates are based on a full-time graduate student (9 credit hours). The Office of Graduate Studies and Research recommends use of a 3% escalation factor for estimating tuition and fee amounts in multi-year budgets and strongly recommends only requesting the cost of tuition (not tuition and fees) from extramural sponsors.

Student Eligibility

To be eligible for payment of tuition and fees, a graduate student must meet all of the following conditions:

- The student must have an appointment as a Graduate Assistant (Research/Teaching) of at least 25% time in the semester for which tuition and fees are paid.
- The appointment must be effective the first day of the semester for which tuition and fees are paid.
- The student must be within normative time for the degree program.
